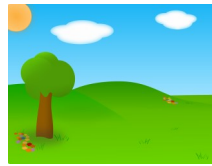

State Road Compost Site

Hours of Operation:

- M, Tu, Th, Fri: 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
- W: 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM
- First and Third Saturdays of each month: 7:00 AM to 11:00 AM

Rules:

- Yard debris must be deposited in the designated areas based on type (green material vs. woody).
- No woody material over 3" in diameter may be deposited at the site.
- The site only accepts residential material generated within the City of Hastings.
- Illegal dumping on the site that violates any of the above requirements will result in up to a \$500 fine.
- Site is under surveillance by digital cameras and Hastings City Police.

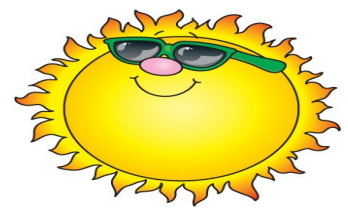
Please Report Street Light Problems

Yard Sale, Garage Sale, Real Estate and other signs

Please remember that all signs, including those advertising yard sales, garage sales and similar events must be placed outside of the public street right-of-way to avoid vision obstructions or distractions for passing motorists. The public right-of-way is typically 33 feet from the centerline of the street, although it may be farther back (up to 50 feet from the centerline) along State Highways or other major streets. Your cooperation in placing all signs outside of the public right-of-way will greatly enhance public safety, and help to eliminate any personal or public liability.
