Sealed proposals for the construction of the WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS will be received by the City of Hastings, 201 East State Street, Hastings, Michigan 49058, until 2:00p.m., Local Time on January 22, 2020.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The contract will consist furnishing of labor, materials, equipment, and construction of the following:

1. New Headworks Building with wastewater pumping, screening, grit removal and a heat recovery ventilation system
2. Site work including new parking area, access road, yard piping and valves, site and building utilities.
3. Service building pipe gallery demolition, painting, and replacement.
4. New return activated sludge pumps, thickened sludge pump, and primary sludge pumps and associated valves and piping.
5. New aeration blower.
6. Primary settling tank and gravity sludge thickener mechanism replacements.
7. Ultraviolet disinfection equipment replacement.
8. Pressurized effluent water system installation.
9. Aeration basin and clarifier handrail and walkway replacements.
10. Administration building addition.
11. WWTP SCADA installation.

Bidders, subcontractors, and suppliers are encouraged to register with HRC to be notified of addenda and relevant bid information. Bidders are required to check the bid site link provided after registration to be made aware of addenda that may be issued prior to the bid date. Bids received from unregistered bidders will be rejected. Hard copy plans and specifications will be available at Hastings City Hall for viewing only after December 23, 2019.

Contractors or Subcontractors performing the work of this contract shall be required to submit previous relevant experience in order to be considered.

A Pre-bid Meeting is scheduled for **2:00 pm on January 7, 2020** at the City of Hastings City Hall Second Floor Council Room, Hastings Michigan 49058. At the meeting, the bid proposal and Project Sequence Requirements will be discussed, and a site walk-through will be held following the meeting.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted in hard copy form on the proposal forms in a sealed envelope clearly marked **“BID FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS”** provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Hastings in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Hastings. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The Contract awarded under this Invitation to is expected to be funded in part from the Michigan State Revolving Fund (SRF) with Green Project Reserve (GPR) projects. SRF requirements are included in Section “Instruction to Bidders” and Section “Supplementary Conditions,” and are a condition of this Contract. The Bid Proposal shall also include a breakdown of the amounts for the Green Project Reserve (GPR) components which are described in detail on the “Bid Form.” The Successful Bidder must comply with the Davis-Bacon Act and comply with Section 436 of P.L.113-76 American Iron and Steel Requirements.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds. The Owner reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.
