Not Eligible to Use Site: Non-Residents
Commercial Contractors
Any Business or Group Charging for Services

Materials Accepted: Compostable Yard Waste Generated from Residences within City Limits
Grass Clippings
Leaves and Sticks
Paper Compostable Bags
Branches Less Than 3" in Diameter & Shorter Than 4' in Length

Not Eligible Materials: No – Materials Generated by Commercial Contractors
No – Materials Generated by a Business or Group Charging for Services
No – Food Waste
No – Compostable Products or Recyclable Goods
No – Plastic Bags or Other Non-Paper Compostable Bags
No – Building Materials or Lumber
No – Branches larger than 3: in Diameter or Longer then 4' in length
No – Large Wood Sections or Stumps

City of Hastings Compost Drop Site is operated only during the warm weather months in Spring, Summer and Fall Seasons. Opening and Closing Dates are weather dependent and are subject to change without notice.

Spring, Fall and Storm Clean-up

Hastings Department of Public Services performs Spring and Fall Curbside Removal of compostable items each year along with Storm Clean up Services as warranted. Dates of these services are communicated to residents via Newsletters (Included in Water Bill Mailings), the City Website <https://hastingsmi.org/> and the City Facebook Page. Clean-up Operation Rules: Pile Sticks and Branches separately from Leaves and Grass
Pile Materials in the Yard just behind the Curb
Begin Piling Material 2-weeks Ahead of a Planned Clean-up Event
Do Not Pile Materials in the Curb Gutter or Street
Do Not Pile Materials that Block a Sidewalk
Do Not Pile Materials that Restrict Vision of Motorists or Pedestrians
Do Not Pile Materials after DPS Crews have Completed Clean-up
