Burning in the City Fire Chief, Roger Caris



There is to be no burning on any street within the City. No burning of paper products, building demolition materials, automobile bodies, tires, plastic or other highly flammable, toxic or explosive materials or furniture of any kind is allowed within the City of Hastings. Any burning that creates a nuisance or hazard to health will not be allowed. There is no burning of leaves within the City. If you intend to burn, it must be clean wood. If you are intending on burning, someone must be in attendance at all times and the fire must be out by 9:00 PM.

You may have a campfire in the City. The fire must be in a ring designed for this purpose and someone must be in attendance at all times. As long as there is someone in attendance there is no time limit on campfires. Again, you can only burn clean wood (no leaves or demolition product).

If the Hastings Fire Department responds to such incidents mentioned above and the person or persons do not have a permit, or they are burning illegal products, they can be billed for the response. Please be aware that there is a minimum charge of \$350.00 for the department to respond to these types of incidents.

To obtain a burning permit for burning within the City, please call 269-205-3208. You will need to leave your name, phone number and what you are going to be burning.
