

PARKING FINES for Time Limit Violations

There are no parking fines for the first violation. The following is a parking fine violation schedule for subsequent violations if paid within ten (10) calendar days, excluding handicap violations which remain \$75.00.

First Violation	FREE
Second Violation (* within 6 months)	\$5.00
Third Violation	\$10.00
Fourth Violation	\$25.00
Fifth Violation	\$50.00
Handicap Violation	\$75.00

Late fees will apply if fine is not paid within ten (10) calendar days.

* If six months have passed between violations the fee schedule begins again with the First Violation.

If you have received a ticket it may be paid at the Police Department located on the 2nd floor of the Hastings City Hall Monday - Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. After hours you may use the drop box located behind City Hall, in the middle drive through lane.

The purpose of parking rules is to enhance public safety, security, and parking availability for all of Hastings residents and visitors. This brochure was designed to help those residents and visitors find the most convenient parking space available to fit their needs. Following these simple rules will save on the cost, inconvenience, and frustration of receiving a ticket. Please look for the helpful signs located throughout town indicating Long Term Parking, Short Term Hourly Parking, and FREE ALL DAY Parking.

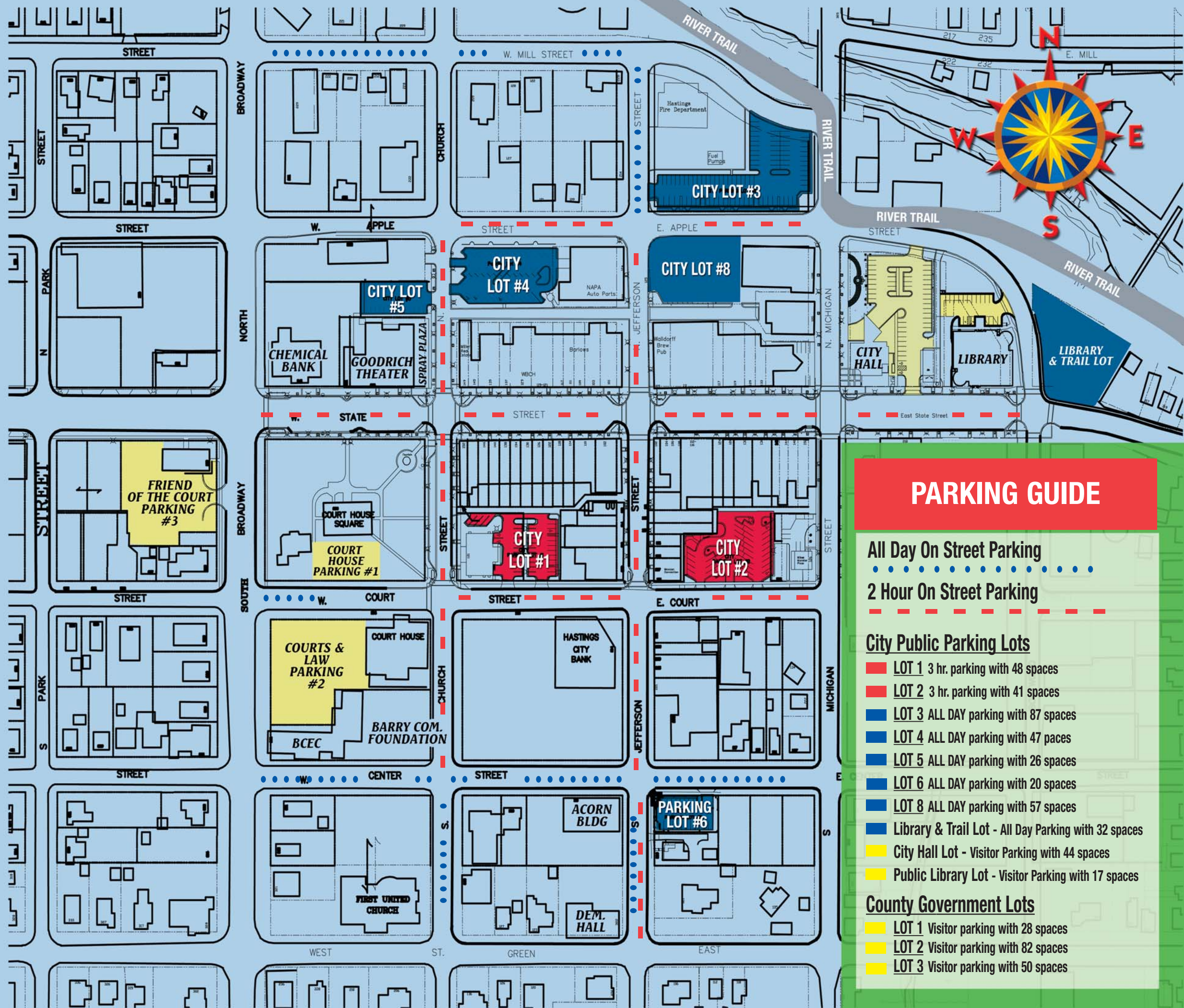
FREE DOWNTOWN MUNICIPAL PARKING

Short Term Parking - Short term parking spaces were designed for someone who may be eating lunch or dinner, enjoying a one or two stop shopping trip or making a quick visit to a service center. These spaces are found on the streets throughout downtown and in Lots 1 and 2.

Long Term Parking - All day parking spaces were designed for someone who is shopping and dining downtown for an extended period of time. These parking spaces are most often found on side streets away from the core downtown or in certain city parking lots. These spaces are found in Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, City Hall Lot, and Library/Trail Lot.

Employee Parking - These parking spaces were designed for employees and owners of businesses that will be spending the entire day or evening in town. These parking spaces are found in areas away from the immediate business district.

Overnight Parking - The City of Hastings permits overnight parking for downtown residents and guests by PERMIT ONLY. Permits can be obtained at Hastings City Hall, 201 East State Street.
